#### **KEY HIGHLIGHTS OF THE CAMP**

- An Arogya Dindi was marched by 50+ doctors and RCUP members.
- We served more than 2200+ Warkaris with free Ayurvedic massages, dental check-ups, and orthopedic check-ups.
- Medicines worth Rs. 4 lakhs were distributed free of charge.
