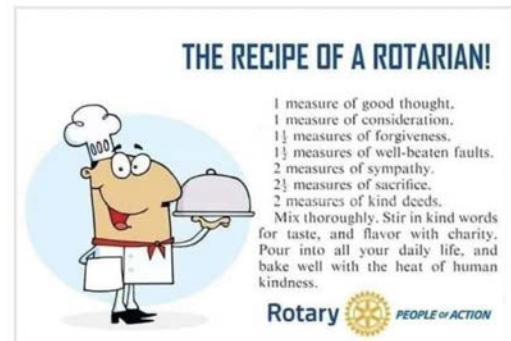
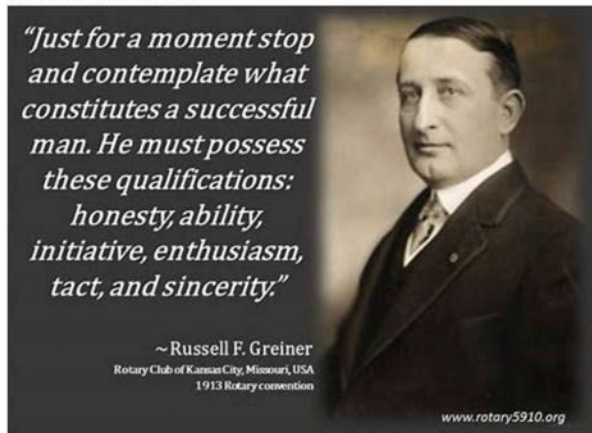


Northeast CAR Rally Unveils Exciting Itinerary: A Journey Across Borders and Capitals

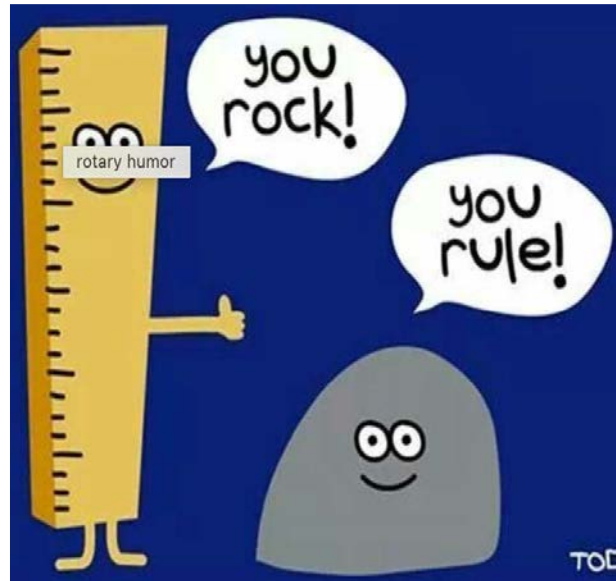

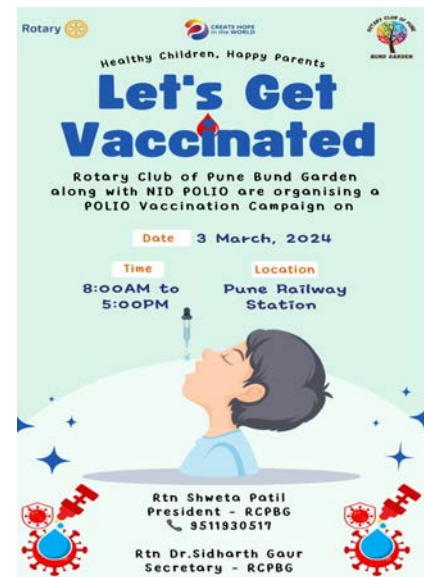


Rotary club of Pune Amanora Upcoming Projects
