


Rotary KBC with Rtn Nitin Dhamale

Rtn Nitin Dhamale, an accomplished Rotarian and entrepreneur, holds a B.E. in Production Engineering and an M.E. in Metallurgy Engineering from the University of Pune. He leads his family business, M/s Cee Dee Vacuum Equipment Pvt. Ltd., which specializes in manufacturing vacuum systems.

Rtn. Nitin joined Rotary in 2002-2003 with the Rotary Club of Pimpri. Over the years, he has championed large-scale, impactful projects, including distributing school bags to over 3,000 students, providing 700 benches, installing 127 water tanks with filters, and leading a literacy initiative across 162 ZP schools. Additionally, he organized daily waste collection awareness campaigns in PCMC involving 3,500 students and a local NGO. He has managed two Global Grants totaling 1.75 crore each and executed a CSR project with Cello Pens, building 24 restrooms in ZP schools.

After 20 years in Rotary, Rtn. Nitin served as Club President in 2018-2019, during which he



completed a record 128 service projects. Under his leadership, the Rotary Club of Pimpri was ranked No. 1 in District 3131, earning him the title of Best Club President. He has also served as convener for various district events, including literacy, Blacktie, AGAC, Foundation, Membership, and PETS. Later, he was recognized as Best Performing Assistant Governor (2021-2022) and Best TRF Director (2022-2023), setting new records in The Rotary Foundation (TRF) for the maximum number of PHS, PHF, and AKS individual donors and contributions of \$2.6 million.

On the personal front, Rtn. Nitin is supported by his wife, Ann Dr. Neelam, a pediatrician and gold medalist. Both are Major Donors - II, and they are blessed with a son, Aryan, who is also a Paul Harris Fellow (PHF).


