

#### Visit to Mana., Tibet

Visiting any place that is ranked either first or last is always quite exciting. I'm going to talk of such a place that exists in Uttarakhand,... a place called Mana (माणा) It's reputation was that of the last Village before entering Tibet. But then after his visit our dear prime minister Modiji has changed this name to being the first village of Bharat.. It has a very popular shop which was called the last tea shop in India (भारत की आखरी चाय की दुकान) which is now the first tea shop in India. (भारत की पहली चाय की दुकान).

Manibhadrapuri is its old name. It is in the district Chamoli 26 km from the Tibetan border. It has an altitude of \$3,200 m and is the beginning of the NH 7 highway of Bharat. It is about 4 Km from the holy site of Badridham. It's a place of sparse local population of less than 13 00 with hundreds of tourists visiting it everyday. We were lucky to have a senior local guide to help us around understanding the many other places of significance. There are many distinct spots of historical and mythological background revered by many.

The Vyas gufa the Ganesh cave (gufa), the Bhim Pul, the Swargarohan Dwaar.. the gateway to heaven, are. Just some of the sites with ancient references, with a modern Saraswati mandar to add to the beauty.

World's largest epic the Mahabharata of more than 1 lakh shlokas was dictated uninterrupted by the sage Vyas in his cave and was put down on paper by lord Ganesh in the Ganesh gufa. Rishi Vyas also narrated the Vedas to his four disciples Pail, Vaishampayan, Jaimini and Sumant who compiled the four Vedas Rigveda, Yajurveda, Saamveda and the Atharva veda.

The Rock cave and the corresponding temple have a rock structure behind that is similar to layers of scriptures that were written down by lord Ganesh.


Vyas was disturbed by the sound of Saraswati river and so cursed her to disappear. At this point, she disappears as soon as she merges with Alaknanda.

These two form the first confluence or prayag known as the Vishnu Prayaag. The Pandavas are said to have ascended to the heavens from this point onwards, crossing the Saraswati river over a huge boulder. It was placed there by Bheem to help them cross to the other side.

Further down, the path gradually rising upwards is a very difficult Trek.

A beautiful modern Saraswati temple and a gateway to heaven known as swarga Rohan dwaar has been built there by Patangrao ji Kadam. In the melting glaciers and cool weather, there are beautiful flowers that bloom enhancing the beauty of nature around. Drinking a tasty herbal local drink in the 'Bharat ki pehli Chai ki dukaan' I started off my return journey to Pune.

प्रसिद्ध अभिनेत्री स्मिता जयकर यांनी लिहिलेले आणि कर्तबगार प्रशासकीय अधिकारी नीता सत्यनारायण यांनी भवानुवादित केलेले हे पुस्तक आध्यात्मिक जीवनाचे आणि तदनुषंगाने प्राप्त होऊ शकणाऱ्या सुखी, समृद्ध, आनंददायी जीवनाचे सच्चे मार्गदर्शक आहे. गुरुदेव प्रभुजी ठक्कर, चेन्नई येथील बननेस स्पिरिचुअल युनिव्हर्सिटीचे श्री. भगवानजी आणि अम्माजी यांच्या शिकवणुकीवर आधारित असे हे पुस्तक सामान्य जनांना आध्यात्मिक बनण्यासाठी दीपस्तंभासमान आहे.

वरवर पाहता अभिनय आणि अध्यात्म हे परस्परिवरोधी भासत असले तरी हे त्यांच्या व्यक्तित्त्वाचे दोन पैलू आहेत. एका संतापी, चिडिचिड्या, मत्सरी, निराशाजनक विचारांच्या प्रभावाखालील अभिनेत्रीचे आध्यात्मिक साधनेमुळे एका शांत, सुखी, आनंदी आणि संयमित व्यक्तिमध्ये कसे परिवर्तन झाले याचा रंजक प्रवास या पुस्तकात आहे. आध्यात्मिक मार्गदर्शन करताना त्यांच्या व्यावहारिक आणि आध्यात्मिक अनुभवांविषयी त्या वाचकांबरोबर खुल्या मनाने चर्चा करतात. कोणत्याही प्रसंगाकडे बघण्याचा आपला दृष्टिकोन आणि आपला प्रतिसाद हेच आपल्या दु:खाचे मूळ कारण असते. त्यामुळे आपणच आपल्या दु:खाचे कर्ते-करिवते असतो. म्हणून आपण स्वतःला बदलले की आपल्या जीवनात अमूलाग्र बदल घडून येतात. यासाठी आवश्यक असलेल्या अंतर्गन आणि बाह्यजगत यांच्यात संतुलन साधण्याच्या प्रयत्नांना लेखिका अध्यात्म म्हणून संबोधित करते.

अध्यात्म ही जीवन जगण्याची एक स्वतंत्र शैली असून एका नव्या दृष्टिकोनातून जगाकडे पाहण्याची वृत्ती आहे. ती कोणत्याही धर्माशी संबंधित नाही. ती खऱ्या अर्थाने धर्मनिरपेक्ष आहे. तिला स्थळ-काळ-परिस्थितीचे कोणतेही बंधन नाही. यात दुसऱ्याला नव्हे तर स्वत:लाच आतून बदलायचे आहे. कोणाशीही तुलना किंवा स्पर्धा करायची नसून स्वत:लाच आरशात पहायचे आहे. स्वत:ला समजावून घ्यायचे आहे. पड्रिपूंचा त्याग करायचा आहे. ईश्वरी इच्छेशी जुळवून घ्यायचे आहे. मनाची तन्मयता आणि दैवी चिन्मयता यांची एकरूपता साधायची आहे...!

आध्यात्मिक विचारांकडे आकर्षित होणाऱ्या साधकांना अनेक प्रश्न असतात, शंका-कुशंका असतात. त्यांची समर्पक उत्तरे लेखिकेने विस्तृत विवेचनाद्वारे दिली आहेत. पहिला महत्त्वाचा प्रश्न म्हणजे, 'आपण आध्यात्मिक केव्हा बनायचे...?' पुस्तकाच्या शीर्षकातच लेखिकेने हे उत्तर दिले आहे आणि ते अतिशय योग्य आहे. पढील स्वाभाविक प्रश्न म्हणजे, "आध्यात्मिक व्हायचे म्हणजे काय आणि कसे...?" किंवा "आध्यात्मिक सराव कसे करावेत...?" किंवा "आध्यात्मिक होताना काही त्याग वगैरे करावे लागले का...?" "आहे त्या जीवनशैलीत आध्यात्मिक बनणे शक्य आहे का...?" या आणि अनुषंगाने येणाऱ्या पढील सर्व प्रश्नांना पुस्तकात उत्तरे आहेत. अनुक्रमणिकेवर नजर टाकली तर सर्व छोटेखानी प्रकरांमध्ये एक विशिष्ट क्रम असल्याचे आपल्या लक्षात येईल, वाचन करताना आपल्या सर्व प्रश्नांना यातन समर्पक उत्तरे मिळत जातील, हा विशिष्ठ क्रम म्हणजे वेगवेगळ्या आध्यात्मिक पायऱ्या असल्याचे आपल्या ध्यानात येईल. एकदम घाई नको... एक एक पायरी चढायची आहे. बहसंख्य प्रकरणानंतर दिलेले प्रेरणादायी सुविचार काळजीपूर्वक वाचून अंगीकारायचे आहेत. आध्यात्मिक प्रवासात गुरूची आवश्यकता, गुरूंचे प्रकार, 'झेन' विचार, शिवशक्ती, चैतन्य, अंतर्मनाची जाणीव, त्याचा दैनंदिन जीवनावरील परिणाम, जाणीवांमधील फरक, संतुलन, मन:शांती, भत भविष्याची भीती, ईश्वरी इच्छा, स्वत्वाची ओळख, एकरूपता (एकात्मता-तादातम्य) शरीरातील सप्त चक्रे व चक्रध्यानाद्वारे त्यांचे मंत्रोच्चाराने संतुलन, शरीरकोश, कुन्डलिनी शक्ती, भावबंध, हवन, अंतर्यामी संवाद, भावसमाधी, धानधारणा व त्याची तंत्रे अशा अनेक सविस्तर आणि मार्गदर्शक चर्चा करून शेवटी पुन्हा साधकांच्या शंका-कशंकांचे निरसन लेखिकेने मोठ्या ताकदीने केले आहे.

# **Anns Interest Meet: 24 September 2024**


