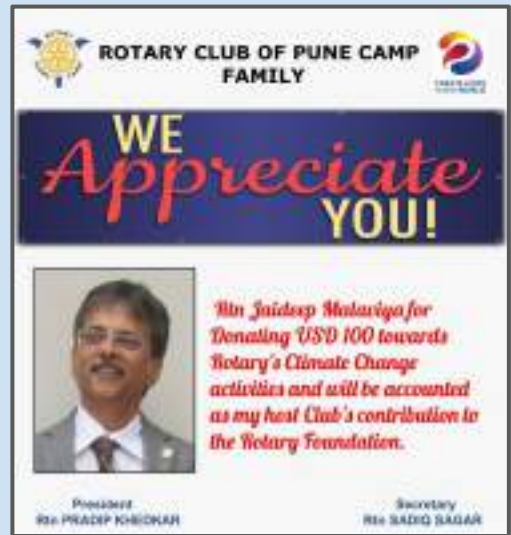
TEJONIDHI FOUNDATION SEMINAR ON -25th NOV

THE EVOLUTION OF CLUBS AND THE BIRTH OF ROTARY; TRACING THE PATH OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

The concept of clubs centered on fellowship and camaraderie dates back to ancient times, but it was during the 16th, 17th, and 18th centuries in London that the prototype for modern clubs began to take shape. Notable establishments such as the Bread Street Club initiated by Sir Walter Raleigh, Ben Jonson's Apollo Club, and Dryden's W's Club were prominent during this period. These gatherings often transpired in coffee houses or inns, fostering conviviality, discussion, and often accompanied by the consumption of alcohol.

In the early 18th century, Joseph Addison observed these clubs, noting in the "Spectator" their exclusivity. He recounted rules barring individuals in the same trade from membership, echoing the Junta Club of Philadelphia established by Benjamin Franklin. Additionally, regulations prohibited members from having their clothing or shoes tailored or mended by anyone outside the club, mirroring an early semblance of the camaraderie found in the inception of Rotary Clubs.

ABOUT ROTARY EMBLEM (WHEEL)

Back in 1905, an engraver and Chicago Rotarian, Montague Bear, designed a simple Rotary wagon wheel, showing movement and dust. It was meant to represent civilization, movement and service work in action. Over time, many Rotary clubs adopted the wheel in one form or another.

In 1922 it was decided to create and develop an official Rotary emblem and in 1925 a gear with 24 teeth and six spokes was officially adopted. To me, the gear teeth around the outside represent the fact that work is to be done.

The six spokes represent the inner direction and path of our Vocational Service through the representation of our membership via the classification system.

The Rotary wheel has been a "magic key" for us, opening doors to special places and unique experiences, including warm hospitality, and yes...even opening the hearts of many new friends.

CELEBRATING 75 YEARS RELATIONSHIP ROTARY INTERNATIONAL & THE UNITED NATIONS

- There is a little known close relationship between the United Nations and Rotary which began in 1942, during the war.
- Rotary clubs from 21 countries organized a conference in London to develop a Vision for the advancement of Education, Science and Culture after the war. That event was a precursor to UNESCO.
- In 1945, a total of 49 Rotarians went to San Francisco, acting as delegates and consultants at the conference on the Charter of the United Nations, which entered into force 3 years later, in 1948. Since then, Rotary and United Nations have been close partners to achieve a more peaceful world.
