Literacy in Slum Areas

"Removing illiteracy is my expertise" PP Adv Sharmitabh Sinha, from Moradabad said when a question was asked to him. He said that he started going to villages with toffees, wafers and some food items to distribute among those poor children whom he wanted to educate.

He would ask the name of a fruit lying besides him and if correctly answered, they were gifted with some food item. This actually worked ,only to know next time that they were more interested in earning money than being rewarded by some toffee or wafer. Basically they were earning members of the family. So next time when he visited the village, he carried with him some grains and flour.

This trick really worked in his favour. More and more children started coming to him to learn and earn grains/ flour from him. He also taught them numbers from 1 to 10. He would also take exams for them. It's a difficult task but definitely not impossible to literate them. Once they seemed to be interested in learning he would motivate them to get enrolled in government schools for further education.



In this project, around 15 volunteers were involved and donation for food items was gathered through members. They are now looking forward to run such projects at construction sites. This can really help these children to motivate to get educated.

This is indeed a very beneficial project and needs long term attention to it. PP Sinha was hopeful that if more citizens and Rotarians took up this cause, just like Polio we could wipe out illiteracy from India.

The event was almost entirely organized and proficiently compared by Rtn Daljeet Kaur Raizada, the Interact Chairman. And also the President of the Inner Wheel of Downtown, who was our synergy partner.

Rotary Club of Poona sponsored 1800 Participation Certificates + 25 Winners certificates. The Inner wheel of Downtown sponsored the Winners Trophies & medal for the Consolation prizes. 20 consolation prize (Medals) were given.
