








Rotary Club of Chicago emblem, circa 1906.

### About Rotary Logo & It's Evolution

- Rotary Club of Chicago, sketched a wagon wheel with 13 spokes as a club emblem in 1906.
- Clubs were invited to submit designs to an emblem committee before the 1912 convention in Duluth, Minnesota, USA.
- In 1920,Bjorge drafted an emblem with six spokes and 24 cogs, giving it a sturdy appearance. In this design, the number of teeth and spokes was intended to reflect a real, working gearwheel.
- In 2013, Rotary expanded the official logo to include the word "Rotary" next to the wheel.
- The Rotary wheel remains our mark of excellence. In addition to being part of the official logo, it may be enlarged for greater impact and used separately but near the logo.


Life is more unusual than fiction Olympic method: This is Shinzo Kanakuri's story.

The Olympic Games were scheduled to take place in Stockholm in 1912. Shinzo took the Trans-Siberian railway and a ship for his extremely strenuous journey of 18 days from Japan to Stockholm. He battled to rest in Stockholm, a city where there were white evenings (where the sun won't ever set). To put it plainly, he was not doing so well. To top it all off, that year Stockholm was experiencing a heat wave. Due to a sprinter collapsing on the track, the 1912 the first fatality Olympics saw associated with the games. Kanakuri decided to run the marathon despite everything. After the 16 mile mark he was so depleted and experienced such incapacitating hyperthermia that he exited the race. A family was having a garden party when he into the garden. They stumbled admitted him and provided him with orange juice. Kanakuri spent an hour drinking simply in that house squeezed orange He was humiliated by his inability to finish the race that he quietly got back to

Japan without illuminating anybody. Since he had gotten back to Japan illuminating anybody, his without name was added to the rundown of missing people in Sweden and the name remained there for a very long time. After more than 54 years, a Swedish investigative journalist wrote story about Kanakuri's Olympics experience and discovered that he was teaching geography in a school in Japan. After that, Swedish Television got in touch with Kanakuri and asked him if he wanted to finish his 1912 marathon because his clock was still running because he hadn't crossed the finish line yet. Kanakuri promptly concurred. Thus, on March 20, 1967, Shinzo Kanakuri, then 75 years old, completed the marathon he had started 54 years earlier. Bengt Petre, the child of the first has invited him with, indeed, squeezed orange. Under "Longest time taken to complete a marathon," Shinzo Kanakuri's name appears in the Guinness Book of World Records for longest marathon from 1912-1967






