HEALTH CORNER by Ann Ashwini Joshi

My Secret Recipe ----- पाच - तीन - दोन

हा उपचार मी स्वतःच तयार केलेला आहे आणि तो अनेकांनी आजवर वापरून पण पाहिलेला आहे.

ही माझी बहुचर्चित आणि खूप जणांना उत्तम उपयोगी पडलेली अशी रेसिपी आहे.
५ भाग मेथी दाणे, ३ भाग ओवा, २ भाग मोहरी असे मिश्रण करून ठेवावे.

हे मिश्रण पचनसंस्थेच्या कुठल्याही प्रॉब्लेम साठी अतिशय गुणकारी आहे. म्हणजे डायरिया, डिसेंट्री, पोटदुखी, अपचन, अजीर्ण या सर्व गोष्टींसाठी ते उपयोगी ठरतं.

एक टेबलस्पून मिश्रण हे पाण्याबरोबर गिळून टाकायचे. सर्व दाणे, म्हणजे मेथी पण, ओवा पण आणि मोहरी पण अखखेच असतात. ते वाटायचे, दळायचे वगैरे काही नाही. आहेत तसेच गिळून टाकायचे. जास्त प्रमाणात त्रास असेल तर गरम पाण्याबरोबर घ्यायचे. एरवी साध्या पाण्याबरोबर पण चालतात. याचा फारच चांगला गुण येतो.

उदाहरणार्थ, समजा जुलाब होत असतील तर, पहिल्याच जुलाबा नंतर एक मोठा चमचाभर मिश्रण गिळून टाकावे. कदाचित दुसरा झाला तर परत एकदा घ्यावे. तिसऱ्यांदा घ्यायची वेळ साधारणपणे येतच नाही इतकं हे गुणकारी आहे. आणि याच्यात अपायकारक काहीच नाही. या सर्व गोष्टी आपल्या नेहमीच्या आहारातल्याच असतात. म्हणजे आम्ही तर, एखाद्या दिवशी खूप जड जेवण झालं तर, त्यानंतर एक चमचाभर मिश्रण घेऊनच टाकतो आणि त्याचा चांगला फायदा होतो. प्रवासातही एक मोठी डबी हे मिश्रण बरोबर ठेवले तर नक्कीच उपयोगी ठरते.

६४ कला

आपलं पारंपरिक ज्ञान किती समृद्ध आहे याचा अनुभव आपल्याला वेगवेगळ्या कारणांमुळे वेगवेगळ्या प्रकारे येत असतो. आपल्या कलबची यावर्षीची प्रोग्रॅमची थीम आहे "चौसष्टकला".

चौदा विद्या चौसष्ट कला, हे आपण खूप वेळा ऐकलं असलं तरी त्या चौसष्ट मध्ये कशाकशाचा अंतर्भाव आहे हे आपल्याला माहिती असतंच असं नाही. मी ही ह्या निमित्ताने ते आवर्जून नीट पाहिलं तेंव्हा थक्क व्हायला झालं. आपल्याला सहज माहिती असतात त्या... नृत्य, गायन, अभिनय, शिल्प, चित्र, लेखन, पाकसिद्धी, केशभूषा, वेशभूषा... अशा. आपल्याआपल्या आवडीप्रमाणे, कौशल्याप्रमाणे आपण त्यात मुशाफिरी करत असतो.

पण यंत्र मातृका (विविध यंत्रांची निर्मिती करणे), कायाकल्प, (वृद्ध व्यक्तीला तरुण करणे), मेष कुक्कुटलावक युद्धविधी (कोंबडे मेंढे यांच्या झुंजी लावणे) म्लेंच्छित कला विकल्प (परकीय भाषाज्ञान) अशाही गोष्टींचा समावेश त्या काळात कला म्हणून केला आहे हे वाचून मला तरी हा सगळा विचार करणाऱ्या, करू शकणाऱ्या आपल्या पूर्वजांचं खूप कौतुक वाटलं आहे.

अतिशय साध्या, पुष्पहार गुंफण, किंवा कपाळावर तिलक लावणे ह्या सारख्या गोष्टी कलेत परावर्तित केल्या की त्यात किती वैविध्य आणता येईल याचा आपसूकच विचार होत असेल. एवढंच काय, वैजापिकी विद्यादान (दुसऱ्यावर विजय मिळवणे), छलीक योग (दुसऱ्याला हातोहात फसवणे), इंद्रजाल(गारुड, जादूटोणा यांचं ज्ञान) अशा थोड्या negative वाटणाऱ्या गोष्टींची पण उपयुक्तता ह्या निमित्ताने लक्षात आली.

एका वर्षात ह्या सगळ्या कलांची ओळख करून देणं अवघड तर खरंच. पण आपण सगळे मिळून त्यातलं आपल्याला काय शक्य आहे त्याचं सादरीकरण करण्याचा आणि इतर कलांविषयी निदान जाणून तरी घेण्याचा प्रयत्न करणार आहोत. आपले monthly member groups सुद्धा त्या दृष्टीने करण्याचा प्रयत्न केला आहे.
