Rotary International President's Message for December is focused on Disease Prevention and Treatment. This month, Rotary members are devoted to fighting and preventing diseases, from setting up temporary clinics, blood donation centers, and training facilities in underserved communities to designing and building infrastructure allowing doctors, patients, and governments to work together. Rotary members combat diseases like malaria, HIV/AIDS, Alzheimer's, multiple sclerosis, diabetes, and polio.

Rotary makes amazing things happen, like providing clean water to fight Guinea worm disease, reducing HIV infection in pregnant women, and ending polio in 122 countries. The Rotary Foundation is changing the world by providing grants for projects and activities around the globe and in your own backyard.

Rotary members have hundreds of health projects underway around the world at any given time. Rotary members can get involved at a local level, such as funding a free health clinic in Panvel, India. Rotarians can also support studies, help immunize people, and improve drinking water and the sanitation infrastructure.

This December, Rotary Disease Treatment and Prevention Month, gain inspiration to take action to fight and prevent disease in your community by: supporting health education programs, partnering with medical institutions or ministries of health to help immunize people, supporting continued education and training for health workers, and improving and expanding access to affordable health care in under-served areas. Rotarians can also enhance existing disease prevention and treatment projects or expand them with guidance from a Rotarian District Group.

### Parikrama – 2023 – Car Rally


The Rotary Club of Panvel Mahanagar enthusiastically welcomed the district car rally
