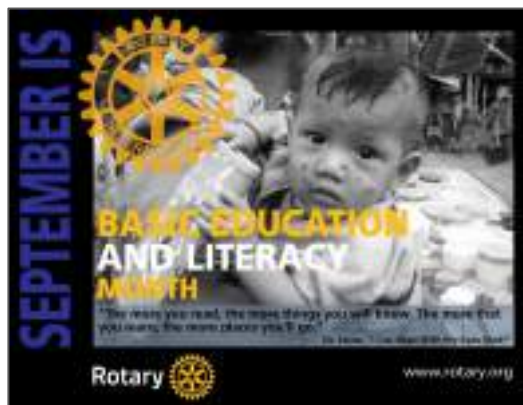

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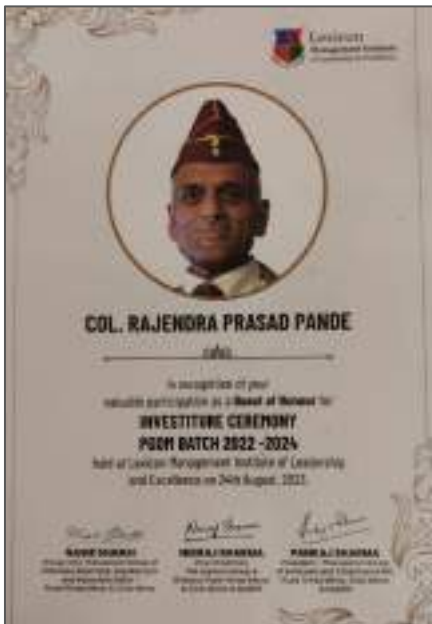

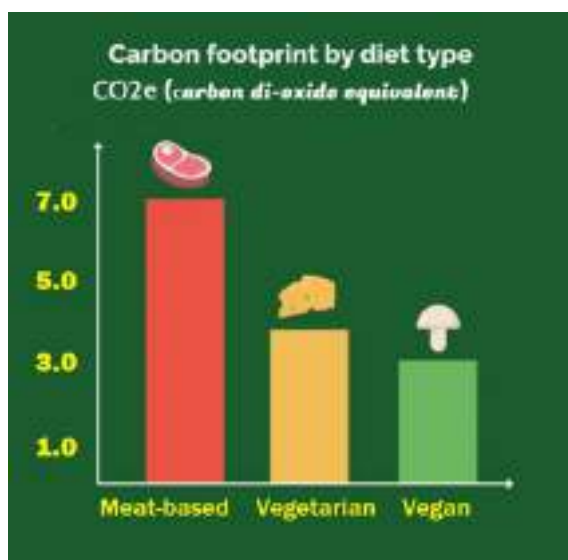


Go Vegetarian, Reduce Global Warming

Our planet is heating up owing to hazardous gases emissions like Carbon dioxide thus causing Global Warming.

More agricultural land is used and more trees are cut to raise cattle than all other domesticated animals causing deforestation. A vegetarian diet requires two-and-a-half times less the amount of land needed to grow food, compared to a meat-based diet.

51 percent of worldwide greenhouse-gas emissions can be attributed to animal agriculture, specifically to cattle, buffalo, sheep, goats, camels and pigs which are raised and killed for food.



People who eat more than 0.1 kg of meat per day—about the size of a deck of playing cards—generate 7.2 kg of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e) each day,

while vegetarians generate 3.8 kg of CO₂e, respectively. That means, according to this study, the dietary emissions for meat-eaters is around 100 per cent higher than for vegetarians as shown in the figure above.

By eating vegetarian food for a year one can save the same amount of emissions as a family taking a small car off the road for 6 months. You might not be able to stop using your car in day-to-day life, but you can choose to eat veggie food.
