



Cliffhanger, India's signature ultracycle race. Most recently, he added the prestigious Paris–Brest–Paris (PBP) to his list of accomplishments, successfully completing the 1,200 km (750 mi) bicycle race from Paris to Brest and back to Paris. As a dedicated cycling mentor for the Panvel Cycling Club, he continues to inspire and guide aspiring cyclists in their own journeys towards athletic excellence.
