MAHATMA GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION

&

On October 2, 2024, the Rotary Club of Pen and the Mahatma Gandhi Library, Pen, jointly celebrated the birth anniversaries of Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri with great enthusiasm. During the event, tributes were paid to the portraits of Mahatma Gandhi, Lal Bahadur Shastri, and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar at the Mahatma Gandhi Library. Additionally, the library was cleaned as part of the celebration.

2) LECTURE ON

On the third day of the Navratri festival, October 5, the Rotary Club of Pen organized a lecture on De-addiction and Cyber Safety for students and their parents. Advocate Dr. Neeta Kadam from the Women's Judicial Board for Juvenile Justice was invited as the keynote speaker for the session. Around 35 students and their parents benefited from this lecture.

In her speech, Advocate Dr. Neeta Kadam provided valuable guidance on how students can stay away from addiction and the potential crimes arising from excessive use of mobile phones. She emphasized the importance of using technology responsibly. The parents appreciated the session and requested such lectures and guidance programs to be conducted regularly. The project was successfully conducted in a very positive and engaging atmosphere.

3) DANDIYA CELEBRATION AT AAI DAY CARE CENTRE

(Vocational Training centre of special children)

In keeping with the values of diversity and equality, male members of the Rotary Club of Pen also participated in the Kumari Poojan. The girls were given Owalni (a traditional blessing ritual) and gifted beautiful presents. Snacks were distributed to all students as part of the celebration. The program was graced by RCC member teachers of Aai Day Care and Mrs. Mansi Patil, Rector of the Government Tribal Girls' Hostel.

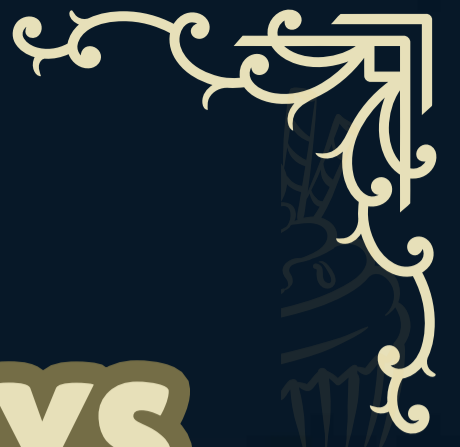
