President Droupadi Murmu grants assent to Women's Reservation Bill

President Droupadi Murmu has given her assent to the Women's Reservation Bill which was passed by both the Houses during the recent special session of Parliament. The Central government has issued a gazette notification for the legislation which is also called Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam. After the President's assent, now the legislation has become a law.

The law provides for 33 percent reservation to women in the Lok Sabha and State Assemblies as well as Delhi Assembly. 33 percent reservation for women belonging to SCs and STs will also be provided within the existing quota for this category.


On 9th August, Our WINS Director Dr.Geetha Mohan visited Rashtrapati Bhavan for a 30 Minutes interaction with our President of India

Help us Save the Farmers in Takrarwadi Village near Pune

We visited a village Takrarwadi this weekend which Rotary adopted in our "Happy Village" concept long ago.

The village is now having a crisis. In Western Maharashtra lack of rainfall this year has created catastrophic problems for farmers. There is no fodder available for cattle and farmers are bleeding financially. The fodder they usually grow has also dried and they are forced to buy from outside.

Villagers who are basically poor farmers are on the verge of selling all their cattle. No livestock means no economic activity and it will eventually lead to hunger and we all know what it will translate into. We want to save the village. They asked for our help for Survival for six months. They have 170 cattle and the daily expense is 9 K-10 K, which means they need support of somewhere around 18 Lakhs in six months to survive this year.

We are crowdfunding the contributions. Please help with your donations if you think we can save them. The money is directly collected into the Rotary Club of Pune Amanora. All money contributed will be used to buy fodder for the village. We will try to support you as much as we can.

So far we managed to crowdfund approximately 1 lakh Rupee... We need more funds. Request you all to spread awareness and help up generate funds.


OUR Honorary member and founder of Spherule Foundation Dr. Geeta Bora Global Icon Award
