
















Deep Sandhya





Under Rotary District 3131, the Rotary Club of Pune Camp organized a musical show featuring R.D. Burman's songs to support polio eradication efforts. As part of this event, they invited other clubs from District 3131 to contribute to the cause. The Rotary Club of Pen participated in the event and took on the role of co-host. This program was conducted as a synergy project under the collaboration of the Rotary Club of Pune Camp, the Rotary Club of Pen, and a few other clubs. The Rotary Club of Pen contributed financially to the polio fund and actively supported the event as a co-host.











On November 23, 2024, the Rotary Club of Pen organized a lecture at Anand School's Interact Club for students of grades 8 to 10 on mental health and how to maintain mental and physical balance during exams. Around 120 students from grades 8 to 10 benefited from this program. The students also engaged in a question-and-answer session, attempting to resolve their issues through interaction. The event was effectively conducted through discussions. Members of the Rotary Club of Pen, along with the principal and teaching staff of Anand School, were present for the program.











On November 26, in honor of Indian Constitution Day, the Rotary Club of Pen organized a street play by students from the Tribal Girls' Government Hostel at the Mahatma Gandhi Library in Pen. The students performed an impactful play highlighting certain provisions from the Constitution authored by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar. Through the play, they effectively conveyed messages about preventing violence against women, the right to education for girls, and the need for them to have the freedom to live independently.

The President of the Mahatma Gandhi Library, Mr. Arvind Wange, honored the students with a cash prize of ₹1,000. Additionally, a lecture by Advocate Neeta Kadam was organized on "Rights and Fundamental Duties under the Constitution." Mrs. Ashwini Gadgil, President of the Ahilya Women's Association, was also present at the event.

Mrs. Mansi Patil, the rector of the Government Tribal Girls' Hostel, was also present at the ceremony. During the event, the official Rotary International certificate was presented to the students.









