Subedar K Narayana was born on 10 Jun 1989 in Peapully Village, Andhra Pradesh. Shri K Veankata Swami father of the JCO is a farmer and his mother is a home maker.

He was selected through a rect rally and joined Indian Army MEG & Centre, Bangalore on 29 Sep 2007 and posted to 5 Engr Regt in Sep 2010.

With the unit, the JCO has served in Dinjan and Jodhpur before proceeding for 54 Rashtriya Rifles (RR). In the year 2015, while serving with 54 RR, the JCO lost his left leg below the knee during an ambush in Naushera sect and was declared Battle Casualty (BC). The JCO was introduced to the rowing sports in the year 2018 and was selected by ARN.

Miss Anita was born on 05 Mar 1995 in Jhotwara Village, Jaipur, Rajasthan, Her father Shri Dhanna Ram Khichar is an Ex serviceman and her mother is a home maker. Miss Anita was introduced to the rowing sports in the year 2023 and was selected by ARN.

Miss Anita is young, dynamic, outstanding and hardworking para athlete. Within her short span of training of only 10 months, she has achieved excellent skills and techniques of para rowing and won Silver medal in 4th Asian Para Games 2022.
